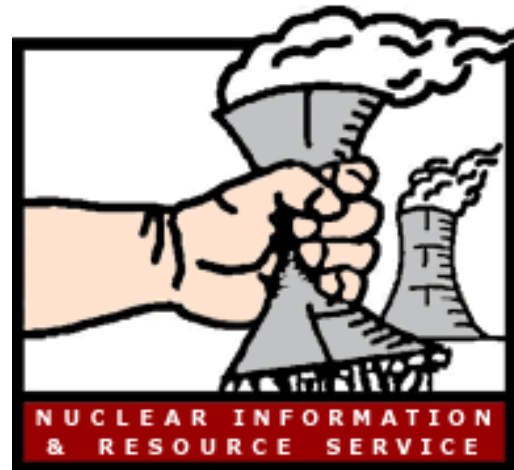

At 7pm Mary Olson will present a workshop on NUCLEAR POWER 101, and we will discuss what can be done to STOP THE LEVY COUNTY NUCLEAR PLANT. A reception will follow at 8:30pm and light refreshments will be served.

This event is a BENEFIT sponsored by the Alachua County Green Party. Donations are welcome, with all proceeds going to the NIRS, to fund our ongoing legal challenge to Progress Energy's application to build a new nuclear power plant less than 50 miles from Gainesville.

In the Petition to Intervene filed by NIRS, the Green Party of Florida and the Ecology Party, Mary Olson presented the oral arguments before the NRC's Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, and was successful in getting several contentions admitted.



Since 1991, Mary Olson has worked with NIRS to assist local activists in stopping nuclear energy, and to promote clean, sustainable, green energy policies. Mary has lobbied on Capitol Hill to stop the nuclear industry from deregulating radioactive waste disposal, and she led the Stop Mobile Chernobyl campaign, which prevented high-level nuclear waste and irradiated fuel from being shipped to Native American lands. Mary has been based in the Southeast since 1999 and is currently working with groups in Florida and across the nation to challenge the first new nuclear reactor proposals in 35 years.
